### PUBLIC MEETING ON NEW ZONING CODE TO BE HELD TONIGHT

**Kenner, LA.** – The first of two public meetings on Kenner’s proposed new Unified Development Code will be held tonight at 6:30 p.m. at the Pavilion at Kenner City Park, 3800 Loyola Drive.

The UDC would revise and update the city’s current comprehensive zoning ordinance, which was adopted in 1978, Kenner Planning Director Jay Hebert said.

The new code was drafted with the help of officials from the University of New Orleans Planning Division after five separate town hall meetings were held during the summer for public comment.

“Public input is critical to a successful code,” Hebert said. “This is a great opportunity for citizens to provide us with comments as we are now in the final stage of this process. Following the public hearing tonight and Thursday, the adoption process will include a public meeting with the planning commission, which will then render a recommendation to the City Council.”
