CODE SWEEP UNCOVERS 152 VIOLATIONS

Kenner, LA. – Code Enforcement inspectors discovered 152 violations during a recent code sweep on Vouray and Loire streets, officials said.

The sweep was the result of complaints from neighbors, and produced the most code violations of any sweep this year.

"We will continue these code sweeps on a weekly basis," Mayor Ben Zahn said. "They are making a difference in our fight against blight and our continuing effort to make Kenner Proud."

Unsafe mechanical conditions	8
Vermin/rodent proofing	5
