UPDATE ON WILLIAMS-VETERANS REPAIRS; OVERNIGHT CLOSURES TO CONTINUE THROUGH THURSDAY NIGHT

Kenner, LA. – The project to repair northbound Williams Boulevard at its intersection with Veterans Boulevard will require overnight lane closures through Friday, according to state officials.

There will be alternating lane closures beginning at 9 p.m. each night this week. Each night's closure continues until 5 a.m. the next morning. The final overnight closure is expected on Thursday night and end at 5 a.m. on Friday.

Overnight work began on Saturday at the intersection, which was damaged in December after a 12-inch water main was ruptured by a contractor working on a fiber optic project. The weekend work was to repair the damaged asphalt, while the work this week involves replacing the loop detectors that operate the traffic signals and installing permanent striping.

Motorists are asked to plan ahead and avoid the intersection, if at all possible.

According to the LA DOTD, motorists can access the latest updates on real-time traffic and road conditions using the 511 Traveler Information system by dialing 511 from their telephone and saying the route or region on which they are seeking information.
