## COUNCILMAN TOM WILLMOTT RECEIVES LEADERSHIP AWARD

**Kenner, LA.** – Kenner Councilman At-Large Division B Tom Willmott, a nine-year veteran of the state Legislature who was elected to the City Council in 2016, was one of just two recipients of the 2017 Leadership for Life Award, presented by Louisiana Right to Life.

Willmott was acknowledged for his work expanding and promoting Louisiana's Safe Haven Law and authoring at eight laws and resolutions designed to make the law more effective in saving lives.

Willmott and former state Sen. Ben Nevers received their awards during the "Bowties for Babies" event held Thursday night at the Louisiana State Museum in Baton Rouge.
