## **38 CODE VIOLATIONS FOUND DURING SWEEP OF TWO COMMERCIAL COMPLEXES**

**Kenner, LA.** – Code enforcement inspectors uncovered 38 code violations during a pair of recent code sweeps of commercial complexes.

Summons were issued to the property owner at 3501 Chateau Blvd. for the following violations: seven counts of unsafe electrical conditions, seven counts of rodent proofing necessary, seven counts of fascia/soffit issues, seven counts of litter/debris and seven counts of unsafe plumbing conditions.

For the property at 2134 Airline Drive, the following summons were issued: one count each for litter/debris, general construction issues and repair or demolition needed.

Mayor Ben Zahn said the code sweeps are a part of the city's continuing crackdown on issues at commercial complexes.

"The owners at 3501 Chateau have been cooperating with my administration and Councilman Cline's office and have offered a revised plan of the area showcasing a possible retail development and city center landscape," Zahn said.

"We appreciate their cooperation and look forward to continued meetings with them," he said. "Again, we will continue to rid Kenner of these persistent violations in our commercial establishments. We thank residents for their patience as we clean up Kenner."

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
