CHANGE IN SCHEDULE, HOURS FOR FARMERS MARKET IN RIVERTOWN

Kenner, LA. - The popular Farmers Market in Rivertown has changed its schedule and extended its hours of operation in order to reach even more customers. The new schedule goes into effect this Saturday.

The market, set up across the street from Exhibition Hall in the 400 block of Williams Boulevard east side parking lot, will be open every Saturday. The market will continue to open at 8 a.m. but will close an hour later, at 1 p.m.

“This is excellent news for anyone looking for the freshest produce, along with expert advice and demonstrations,” Kenner Mayor Michael Yenni said. “Instead of the first and third Saturdays, having this available every Saturday will also bring more people into Rivertown to take advantage of this great market with no worries about traffic or parking.”

The market will be closed three days in connection with the upcoming holiday season: Nov. 29, Dec. 27 and Jan. 3, 2015.

On Nov. 15, the Farmers Market will have its annual *Holiday in the Market*. There will be arts items and crafts, in addition to produce available and the market will be open from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. A highlight of the special holiday market is the fried turkey demonstration at 10 a.m.
