FLASH FLOOD WATCH EXTENDED UNTIL FRIDAY EVENING

Kenner, LA – Despite this morning’s sunny skies, the National Weather Service has extended a Flash Flood Watch for Kenner and most of southeastern Louisiana until Friday evening.

While much of the shower and thunderstorm activity was offshore this morning, that is expected to change with showers becoming more numerous this afternoon and evening before diminishing during the early evening hours. The rain and storms are forecast to return on Friday.

“Additional rainfall amounts of 1 to 4 inches with locally higher amounts are expected through Friday afternoon,” according to the National Weather Service.

A flash flood watch means that conditions are present that could lead to flash flooding. Kenner’s Office of Emergency Management will monitor the weather, and additional information will be released as necessary.
