KENNER FLAGS AT HALF-MAST TO HONOR VICTIMS OF FRENCH TERRORIST ATTACKS

Kenner, LA. – All flags on city buildings in Kenner will be flown at half-mast through sunset on Thursday out of respect to the victims of Friday’s terrorism in France, Kenner Mayor Michael Yenni said.

President Obama issued an executive order, saying “The American people stand with the people of France. Friday’s terror attacks were not just an attack on Parish; they were an attack on all humanity and the university values we share, including the bonds of liberte, egalite and fraternite.

The president also said the U.S. “... will do whatever it takes, working with nations and peoples around the world, to bring the perpetrators of these attacks to justice, and to go after terrorists who threaten our people.”
