'JAZZ BRUNCH' FUNDRAISER TO BE HELD IN RIVERTOWN ON NOV. 23

Kenner, LA. – The first annual Jazz Brunch will be held Nov. 23 in Rivertown to assist in the revitalization of the Rivertown Historic District.

The jazz buffet brunch will be held from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. at The Crossing, 519 Williams Blvd., and is hosted by the Historic Rivertown Redevelopment Association, in partnership with the city of Kenner. Tickets are \$30 and the event has open seating. Reserved tables are available for parties of 10.

Kenner was named a Main Street community earlier this year by state officials, becoming the first in Jefferson Parish and only the 36th in the state. The Jazz Brunch is a yearly event that is supported through the Main to Main grant.

“This is just one of the many benefits of being a Main Street community,” Kenner Mayor Michael Yenni said. “There is advice available from other communities that have revitalized their downtown or historic districts, along with tax breaks and grants. This event is a great opportunity to raise money to hold future events and continue with revitalization plans for Rivertown.”
