## **TOWN HALL MEETING IN RIVERTOWN TO DISCUSS NEW UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT CODE**

**Kenner, LA.** – The first of five town hall meetings to discuss zoning issues surrounding the creation of a new Unified Development Code for Kenner will be held tonight (July 14) at 6:30 p.m. in Rivertown.

The meeting will be in Heritage Hall, 303 Williams Blvd.

The meetings offer an informal opportunity for residents and business owners to talk to elected officials and the Kenner administration on zoning matters.

Kenner's current comprehensive zoning ordinance dates back to 1978 and has been revised more than 130 times in the past 37 years. Officials said the ordinance is outdated and the new code will reduce unnecessary zoning procedures and address issues that did not exist in the 1970s.
