COMMUNITY MEETING SCHEDULED FOR WEDNESDAY ON EAST JEFFERSON LEVEE DISTRICT DEVELOPMENT PROPOSAL

Kenner, LA. – The East Jefferson Levee District will present the details of its plan for a new consolidated facility in south Kenner on Wednesday at 6:30 p.m. in the Exhibition Hall in Rivertown, 415 Williams Blvd.

Residents of District 1 are invited to attend to hear about the plan and to ask any questions of officials from both the East Jefferson Levee District and the Southeast Louisiana Flood Protection Authority – East. The presentation is expected to cover issues including land use, traffic, public safety, parking and tree preservation.

The Levee District plans to consolidate its police and main operations into a single complex located near the St. Charles Parish line and just north of Reverend Richard Wilson Drive. The complex will also include a safehouse that can hold up to 65 employees in the event of a tropical system threatening the area.
