



## MAYOR YENNI SUPPORTS JP PRESIDENT YOUNG STANCE ON ENTERGY LACK OF PROGRESS

**Kenner, LA** – City of Kenner Mayor Mike Yenni expressed his full support of Jefferson Parish President John Young, who lambasted the energy company at a press conference Friday evening.

My sentiments are shared by my entire Council, our Chief of police, and the majority of our residents.”
