KENNER POLICE SEARCHING FOR FOURTH SUSPECT IN RAISING CANE'S ROBBERY, MURDER

Kenner, LA. – Kenner Police Chief Michael Glaser, along with officials from other agencies involved in the investigation into the murder of Raising Cane's shift manager Taylor Friloux, 21, of LaPlace, announced at a press conference Thursday that two suspects in the case have been arrested, a third is in custody and police are searching for a fourth.

Friloux was stabbed and later died after the armed robbery of the restaurant at 3344 Williams Blvd., at approximately 1:30 a.m. on Wednesday. Glaser said surveillance tapes showed she was first stabbed outside the store near the dumpster, then stabbed again inside as she collapsed to the floor and the robbers were on their way out.

Joshua Every, 23, of LaPlace, has been charged with first-degree murder, aggravated burglary, armed robbery and other crimes, along. Mark Crocklen Jr., 24, also of LaPlace has been booked with first-degree murder, armed robbery and criminal conspiracy.

At Thursday's press conference, Glaser said a third suspect is currently in custody and he expected charges to be filed sometime later on Thursday. Police are searching for an unidentified female who also was a part of the robbery, Glaser said.

Agencies involved in the investigation included St. John the Baptist Sheriff's Office, the U.S. Marshal's Gulf Coast Regional Task Force, the Jefferson Parish Sheriff's Office and Crimestoppers. Raising Cane's also assigned support personnel to the Kenner Police Department to assist detectives.
