DROP-OFF RECYCLING SERVICES WILL CONTINUE DESPITE FIRE IN NORTH KENNER PARK CONTAINER

Kenner, LA. – Recycling drop-off services will continue at the North Kenner Park location off of 38th Street between Williams Boulevard and Martinique Avenue despite a fire in the container that was discovered Tuesday, Ramelli Waste officials said.

A temporary replacement will be swapped out Thursday with the damaged container, said Crystal Middlebrook, operations manager for Ramelli.

“There will be no interruption of service,” she said, adding that the new container will look different because there are no City of Kenner stickers. “Once we have the other one repaired, we will switch them out.”

The fire apparently started sometime overnight Monday, Middlebrook said. A police report has been filed; but so far, the cause of the fire is unclear.
