KENNER FLAGS AT HALF-STAFF TO HONOR SUPREME COURT JUSTICE

Kenner, LA. – All U.S. flags on Kenner buildings have been lowered to half-staff to honor Antonin Scalia, Associate Supreme Court Justice, who died on Saturday, Acting Mayor Michael Sigur announced on Wednesday.

President Barack Obama issued a presidential proclamation ordering that all flags on all public buildings and grounds remain at half-staff until sunset on Feb. 20, when Scallia will be buried.

Scalia's chair on the Supreme Court bench, along with the bench itself, were draped with black wool crepe Tuesday – a Supreme Court tradition, while a black drape was hung over the courtroom doors.
