### TWO SEWER PROJECTS TO AFFECT TRAFFIC EARLY NEXT WEEK

**Kenner, LA.** – A pair of sewer repair projects will affect traffic on Monday and Tuesday of next week, weather permitting, Kenner Public Works Director Jose Gonzalez said.

On Monday, BLD Services, LLC will have workers on the west side of the median opening at West Esplanade Avenue and East Louisiana State Drive. That median opening will be closed to traffic; however, the contractor does not expect to close any lanes on West Esplanade, Gonzalez.

That work is expected to take a day to complete, as long as there are no weather delays.

On Tuesday, the contract will move to the vicinity of 3503 East Louisiana State Drive to begin the second sewer repair project. That work will require closing one lane on East Louisiana State Drive. The work, as long as the weather cooperates, is expected to be finished on Tuesday.

The contractor will provide traffic control devices to alert motorists to the lane closure and median closure, Gonzalez said.

Work hours for both projects are 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. The total cost of the two jobs is \$45,000.
