### **MOST POWER RESTORED AFTER ACCIDENT IN SOUTH KENNER**

**Kenner, LA.** – Power has been restored to all but about 80 customers in south Kenner after a truck picking up dumpsters pulled down a wire in front of a business in the 2000 block of 4<sup>th</sup> Street on Thursday, officials said.

The accident happened at 12:10 p.m., originally affecting 1,400 Entergy customers, according to Kenner Emergency Management Director Doug Dodt.

Officials with the Kenner Discovery Health Sciences Academy moved 150 students from the lower school at 300 Williams to the Maine Street campus. School officials said they expect to resume normal carpool activities Friday morning at 8 a.m.

All traffic signals in the area are working and Kenner's Public Works complex was switched to generator power, Dodt said.

The power pole that was knocked down is expected to be replaced by 9 p.m. tonight.
