SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING SET FOR 5 P.M. THURSDAY

Kenner, LA. – The Kenner City Council will meet Thursday at 5 p.m. in a special session to reconsider an ordinance approved at the June 18 meeting to hire a firm to provide auditing services for the council.

The meeting will start at 5 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, 1801 Williams Blvd.

The ordinance to be reconsidered is No. 10936, which approved a four-year professional service agreement with Duplantier, Hrapman, Hogan & Maher, LLP.

All interested parties are invited to attend. The Council normally meets on the first and third Thursdays of the month, but the legislative calendar was amended because of the July 4th holiday and the possibility that some officials and residents would be out of town and unable to attend. The next council meeting is July 9.
