OFFICIALS SEARCHING FOR STOLEN BICYCLE RACK

Kenner, LA. – Kenner officials are asking for help in locating a silver bike rack that was among two installed this summer in Laketown, as part of a federal Recreational Trails Grant Program, and is now missing.

The two bike racks were located in the 5000 block of Williams Boulevard. Kenner officials say one of the racks was taken sometime between Oct. 1 and Jan. 16.

The custom bike racks were paid for with the Recreational Trails grant and there are plans to install more racks at City Park, said Mike Ince, special projects administrator in Kenner's Planning Department.

The Recreational Trails Program for Louisiana is a federal program that helps states provide and maintain recreational trails for motorized and non-motorized uses. Bicycling and pedestrian uses are just a couple of the many recreational trail uses made possible through the program.
