KENNER UNDER A TORNADO WARNING UNTIL 10:45 A.M.

Kenner, LA. – The city of Kenner is under a tornado warning until 10:45 a.m., along with all of northwestern Jefferson Parish, according to the National Weather Service.

The warning was triggered when radar indicated a severe thunderstorm capable of producing a tornado located near Paradis, or about 8 miles southwest of Hahnville and moving to the northeast at 45 mph.

Risks include half-dollar sized hail and flying objects. Residents are urged to move to an interior room on the lowest floor of a sturdy building and avoid windows. Anyone outside should move to the closest substantial shelter.

The area is also under a tornado watch until 2 p.m.
