TRAFFIC SIGN INSTALLATION TO IMPACT WILLIAMS BOULEVARD, 32ND STREET

WORK SET TO BEGIN WEDNESDAY, CONTINUE THROUGH THURSDAY

Kenner, LA. – Motorists in Kenner are advised to be aware of sign installation work that will affect traffic on Williams Boulevard and 32nd Street in central Kenner on Wednesday and Thursday.

Both northbound and southbound traffic on Williams from 33rd Street to Veterans Boulevard will be impacted, as will traffic on 32nd Street heading east to Williams Boulevard.

According to the state Department of Transportation and Development, there will be right and left lane closures to accommodate workers installing traffic signs. However, one lane will remain open at all times on Williams and on 32nd Street.

The work is set to begin Wednesday morning and to continue from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Thursday.
