BROKEN WATER MAIN ON WILLIAMS BOULEVARD NEAR I-10

Kenner, LA. – Kenner officials are at the scene of a broken water main in the 2800 block of Williams Boulevard near Interstate 10. The water main was inadvertently struck by a construction crew, according to Doug Dodt, Kenner Emergency Preparedness Coordinator.

As of 12:45 p.m. a Jefferson Parish water crew had just arrived at the scene, located just off the side of the northbound lanes of Williams. Water was spewing about 20 feet in the air but was draining well and not collecting on the roadway.

Motorists are advised to use caution while driving through the area.
