SWEARING IN FOR TOM WILLMOTT TO BE HELD TUESDAY

Kenner, LA. – Tom Willmott officially makes the transition from the state Legislature to the Kenner City Council when he is sworn in on Tuesday as the Division B At-Large council member.

Willmott, a lawyer and nurse who has held the 92nd House District seat since 2007, was elected with more than 70 percent of the vote earlier this month. He succeeds former Kenner Councilman Keith Conley, who stepped down to become Chief Operating Officer in Jefferson Parish.

Brian Brennan was appointed by the City Council as interim council member after Conley resigned on Jan. 6, 2016. Conley's unexpired term runs until 2018.

"I am grateful that I recently had the chance to meet and talk with a lot of Kenner residents as I campaigned throughout the city for the Council-at-Large position," Willmott said. "I am humbled by all of the support that I received along the way, as well as the outcome of the election."

The swearing-in ceremony will be held at 4 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, 1801 Williams Blvd.
