The Honorable Michael S. Yenni and the Kenner City Council will host a “Day of Remembrance” to honor the fallen men and women of the tragic events of September 11, 2001 on the 10th anniversary. The event will be held Friday, September 9, 2011 at 9:00 am at the Memorial site in Kenner’s Laketown.

On September 11, 2002 the City of Kenner in conjunction with Mr. Louis Muhleisen erected and dedicated a Memorial to honor the fallen heroes of the tragic 911 events. The Memorial consists of a plaque and flag pole at the entrance to the Kenner boat launch where all the community can observe.

Joining us will be Police Chief Steve Caraway, Sheriff Newell Normand and Kenner Fire Chief John Hellmers. Officials from the local area have been invited to participate in the remembrance ceremony along with East Jefferson Director of Emergency Medical Services Michael Guillot.

The Kenner Police Honor Guard and Kenner Fire Department Color Guard will play a big roll in this event. Pastor Erica Jenkins with the Thomas United Methodist Church and other local churches were requested to join in.
