



## KENNER'S NEW PAPERLESS COURT SYSTEM

KENNER, LA- Approximately one month after the official ribbon cutting for the City's paperless court system, Kenner is proud to announce the system's capability to process online credit and debit card ticket payments. The interface for online ticket payments that was built into the new paperless court system is complete and went live late last week.

The capability for those with tickets authorized for payment without a court appearance not only provides an element of convenience for the payees, but increases the likelihood that the City will receive more of the outstanding receivables that provide funding for many sections of its government, including administrative departments and the Kenner Police Department.

Mayor Yenni, along with his administration and Digicomm Systems, Inc., the City's IT consultant and software developer, cut the ribbon for the completed court system just over one month ago. However, the new system has actually been in use for over one (1) year. The Louisiana Municipal Association (LMA) recognized the City of Kenner with its 2011 Community Achievement Award as it is the organization's hope that this innovative system will become a model for many courts across the State of Louisiana.
