This event is being held in conjunction with the Capital Area Corporate Recycling Council, the Green Project and Operation Reach and is for electronic waste generated by residential households only. No items from businesses will be accepted.

Items eligible for collection include:

Items that will not be accepted include:

- Television sets
- Batteries
- Copy machines
- Pesticides
- Fluorescent and neon light bulbs
- Lighting ballasts
- Mercury and mercury containing equipment
- Liquid waste (other than latex paint and used cooking oil)
- Oil-based paint
- Oil and antifreeze
- Ammunition
- Propane tanks
- Appliances
- Paper products
- Plastics
- Tin and aluminum cans
