KENNER BUDGET HEARINGS FOR 2010 START MONDAY

Members of the Kenner City Council will meet in special session Monday afternoon to hear recommendations of Mayor Ed Muniz for the city's 2010-2011 fiscal budget.

The hearing gets underway at 1 p.m. in the city council chamber at 1801 Williams Boulevard, Kenner, and is open to the public.

The budget is divided into 24 parts for hearing purposes. If the council is unable to go through all of them Monday, it will reconvene Tuesday to finish the work.

The Kenner City Charter requires that the City Council adopt a new budget by June 15 each year for the fiscal year that starts each July 1.

The proposed operating budget is \$2.8 million less than the operating budget for the current fiscal year; and the capital budget is \$3.4 million less than the current capital budget.
