### **KENNER AND AT&T SIGN AGREEMENT ON U-VERSE TV SERVICE, DONATES \$7,500 TO KENNER FOOD BANK**

AT&T officially kicked off its new U-verse television service in Kenner Thursday afternoon with the formal signing of a contract prior to a meeting of the Kenner City Council.

AT&T hosted a brief gathering with refreshments and souvenirs in the council chamber prior to the contract signing.

The event included presentation of a \$7,500 check for the Kenner Food Bank and door prizes for guests and the general public who were in attendance.

The new agreement was the result of many weeks of negotiations between the city and the communications utility. Installation of service to Kenner customers will begin in several days. U-verse uses a fiber optic technology.

Mayor Michael S. Yenni and city council members said they were glad that a new high technology TV service is now available for Kenner citizens and added that U-verse offers the city an opportunity to generate new revenues for the city budget.

Sonia Perez, president of AT&T Louisiana, said her company will aggressively move forward with installation of U-verse infrastructure simultaneously in each city council district so the service will be available quickly across Kenner.

City officials said they look forward to a quality service that is beneficial to all concerned.
