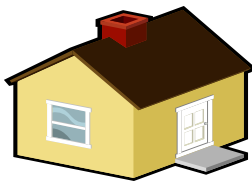

- ❖ Meet income eligibility guidelines, etc.

- ❖ Able to pay at least 25% of amount overdue
- ❖ Have not received a housing or utility assistance payment from the City of Kenner or other social service agency in the last 12 months
Community Development works in partnership with other social service agencies such as Associated Catholic Charities, Jeff CAP, Consumer Credit, and others.
- ❖ Proof of occupancy and residency must be provided
- ❖ Proof of ALL household members income is required
- ❖ Must NOT be on any type of rent subsidy program (Ex. Section 8, Dap, FEMA, CLC, PHA)
