POPULAR 80'S TRIBUTE BAND, "THE MOLLY RINGWALDS" RETURN TO KENNER'S "MUSIC IN THE PARK" THIS FRIDAY

After a smashing close of the free concerts in 2007, **The Molly Ringwalds**, come back for the seventh week of this year's Music in the Park, Kenner's free concert series.
