4-BLOCK CODE SWEEP ON VOURAY STREET NETS 31 VIOLATIONS

Cable TV also Turns up 33 Illegal Connections

Kenner enforcement officials conducted a code sweep on Vouray Street between Loire Drive and Macon Street Thursday and registered a variety of building code violations ranging from missing clothes dryer vent covers to electrical problems and abandoned vehicles.

Assistant Code Enforcement Director Missy Heyl said representatives from Cox Cable TV took part in the sweep and turned up 33 illegal connections to the cable system.

She listed the violations as follows:

- 11 – mechanical violations
- 6 – electrical violations
- 4 – building maintenance violations
- 4 – abandoned vehicles
- 2 – plumbing violations
- 2 – shed violations
- 2 – grass and litter violations

Code enforcement officials routinely conduct sweeps of problem areas in the city to help improve neighborhoods and reduce violations that can lead to dangerous conditions in and around buildings.
