WATER MAIN BREAK DISCOVERED IN SOUTH KENNER

Parish Crew Arrives to Find and Fix Break at Oxley & 9th Streets

Jefferson Parish Water Department Crews were on the scene of a water main break in south Kenner Monday morning in an effort to locate and repair the break.

Water service would have to be disrupted in a one-block radius around the intersection of Oxley and 9th Streets in the process.

Tyrell Chatman, East Bank superintendent for the water department said the break in the six-inch main was discovered as the result of water seepage into an adjacent sewerage manhole. The utility services are subsurface and heavy equipment was called in to find the break.
