Kenner, LA. – (JAN. 12, 2024) The city of Kenner's administrative offices will be closed on Monday, Jan. 15th in observance of the Martin Luther King Jr. holiday.

Members of the media are invited to attend the City of Kenner's 40th Annual Martin Luther King Day parade and commemorative celebration that will take place on Monday, Jan. 15th beginning at Providence Baptist Church located at 11509 Jefferson Highway. The celebration will commence with a march that begins at Providence Baptist Church at 11am (lineup starts at 9am) and will end at the A.P. Clay Center located at 200 Decatur St. where a program honoring the life and legacy of Dr. Martin Luther will follow. *In the case of inclement weather, the ceremony will be moved indoors at Pilgrim Baptist Church located at 2114 Reverend Richard Wilson Drive.
