CITY OF KENNER ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICES TO CLOSED TOMORROW, TUESDAY, JANUARY 16TH DUE TO SEVERE WINTER WEATHER FORECAST AND THE POTENTIAL FOR DANGEROUS ROAD CONDITIONS

Kenner, LA (January 15, 2024) - Freezing rain is forecast for the New Orleans Metropolitan Area tonight, including the City of Kenner. This precipitation may result in possible hazardous road conditions. To ensure the safety of our employees, the City of Kenner's administrative offices will be closed tomorrow, Tuesday, January 16th. Please be advised that these closures also include recreation activities, food bank distributions and Mayor's Court/Clerk of Court.

Temperatures will continue to drop tonight with freezing rain arriving in our area around 10pm and extending overnight according to the National Weather Service. By Tuesday morning, a Freeze Warning and Wind Chill Advisory will be in effect and all day Tuesday will remain bitterly cold.

The City of Kenner's Emergency Management Center continues to monitor the weather and advises residents to secure all pets, plants and pipes.

For real time notifications, we encourage residents to sign up for Jefferson Parish Community Alerts (JP ALERTS). The Jefferson Parish Community Alert System is an alert notification system that allows officials to immediately contact you during a major crisis or emergency.
