CITY OF KENNER POST HURRICANE FRANCINE RECOVERY UPDATES; CURBSIDE GARBAGE COLLECTION RESUMES TODAY

Kenner, LA. – (SEPTEMBER 13, 2024) The City of Kenner's recovery and response continues.

City Actions and Updates:

- Curbside garbage collection resumes today on its regular schedule.
- Curbside recycling collection resumes Monday, September 16th.
- Kenner's drop site (dump site) will be open tomorrow and Sunday (September 14th and 15th) with normal hours of operation (9am-3pm)
- Kenner's sewerage system is operating at full capacity. Residents no longer need to conserve water.
- Repairs to Williams Blvd in Rivertown are complete. Williams Blvd is fully open and passable.
- The 200 block of 27th Street next to the 27th Street and Salem Lift Station is closed for safety reasons due to the development of a sink hole.
- Some traffic signals remain without power throughout Kenner; motorists are asked to proceed with extreme caution.
- Kenner Government Offices will reopen Monday, September 16th at 8:30am.
- Kenner's Emergency Operation Center remains activated today. The phone number for non-emergency assistance is 504-468-4357. Reminder, call 911 for emergencies.
- The Market at Kenner City Park is cancelled for Saturday, September 14th.
- Saturday shows are cancelled at the Planetarium as the facility remains out of power.
- The Kenner Boat Launch at Laketown remains closed until further notice.
