MAYOR MIKE GLASER'S STATE OF THE CITY PRESENTATION HIGHLIGHTS MAJOR PROGRESS AND PARTNERSHIPS IN KENNER

Kenner, LA- (December 5, 2024) On November 19, 2024, The Kenner Business Association held its annual November luncheon where Mayor Mike Glaser presented Kenner's State of the City address. A booming Rivertown, exciting plans for the future of the Laketown area, a brand-new Treasure Chest Casino, and the revival of the shuttered Kenner Parks and Recreation Department are just a few of the topics covered.

The State of the City also covers millions of dollars in infrastructure projects that were left dormant and are now moving forward to completion, as well as the many private public partnerships Kenner has established that bring economic development, sports, and several other amenities that enhance Kenner's quality of life. The presentation goes on to talk about tough decisions that could no longer be ignored, including properly funding the Kenner Fire and Wastewater Departments.

"When I took office in July 2022, Kenner was on a drawn-out losing streak across many areas. Today, we're well on our way to the City's most epic comeback," Mayor Glaser said.
