The City of Kenner hosts the Krewe of Isis Parade and the Kenner Gras Celebration this Saturday, March 1st; Traditional Lundi Gras Festivities with the Krewes of Argus and Zulu set for Monday, March 3rd in Rivertown

The City of Kenner is excited to present Carnival in Kenner 2025, offering a line-up of family friendly Mardi Gras events that offer a suburban alternative for Carnival celebrations.

Kenner, LA – (February 28, 2025)- On Saturday, March 1, 2025, the Krewe of Isis is set to hit the streets of the City of Kenner for another fun-filled, family friendly parade. With nearly 200 members, Isis celebrates its 52nd year and is the largest and oldest all female Mardi Gras organization in Jefferson Parish. Isis is also the oldest consecutively parading traditional Carnival organization in Jefferson Parish.

Prior to the start of the Isis parade, Saturday's events will begin at 2pm with Kenner Gras, a festival at Kenner City Park (3800 Loyola Drive) featuring food trucks and vendors, as well as live music by Confracflow beginning at 3pm. The Kenner Gras celebration is situated on the parade route and is free to the public. It will conclude at 6pm as the Krewe of Isis begins to roll.

On Monday, February 12, 2024, the 400 block of Williams Blvd in Kenner's historic Rivertown will be abuzz with Carnival excitement and fanfare as the City of Kenner will host the annual meeting of the King of Argus and the Queen of Zulu, along with their courts, at its traditional Lundi Gras

celebration. Mayor Mike Glaser and the Kenner City Council will welcome these groups as well as family, friends and members of the community.

Lundi Gras festivities are set to begin at 11am with the Meeting of the Courts Ceremony followed by a parade through the streets of Rivertown that will include the Krewe Du Kenner, a family friendly wagon parade that will add to the fun! All are welcome to bring decorated wagons to join this parade. No pre-registration required. Following the parade, the Top Cats will hit the stage and play everyone's favorite rock and roll hits while participants enjoy great food and visit the vendors offering arts, crafts and a variety of treats. Festivities are scheduled to conclude at 3pm.
