## **Mayor Mike Glaser Hosts Upcoming Town Hall Meetings for Public Input on Recycling and Drop Site Services**

**Kenner, LA- August 28, 2025** Kenner Mayor Michael Glaser invites residents to attend two upcoming town hall meetings to provide input on the future of curbside recycling and drop site services in the City. The City's current contract for recycling and drop site services will expire in February 2026, and these town halls are being held to ensure that residents have a voice in shaping the next phase of these services.

The meetings will include a presentation of the current costs, future projections, and several options for how these services may be provided moving forward. Residents will have the opportunity to share feedback to help guide the City's decision-making process.
