



Curbside Trash Collection Guidelines

HOUSEHOLD WASTE

The city provides for the collection of containerized household garbage twice per week. All household waste should be securely bagged and placed in the green Waste Pro container for pickup.

BULKY WASTE

Un-containerized bulky waste, including yard waste, construction debris, fence boards, and tree limbs, must be neatly stacked or bagged curbside. Bulky waste is limited to ten (10) cubic yards. ANY debris generated by a yard service or tree removal contractor must be removed by the contractor.

LARGE ITEMS / CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS

Items such as furniture, remodeling debris, white goods (appliances, refrigerators, ranges, water heaters, freezers, etc.), large toys and other waste that do not fit into the Waste Pro roll-out cart shall be placed next to the container. Do not place objects up against mailboxes, light poles, fire hydrants, etc. Residents are responsible for having the Freon removed from all appliances containing Freon, along with a certifying sticker, prior to being placed curbside for pickup.

Debris generated from residents performing light construction work that does not require a permit (carpeting, padding, etc.) may be placed curbside and is limited to ten (10) cubic yards.

Waste Pro is not required to remove construction debris placed curbside by a general contractor or generated from new construction or demolition where such work required a permit. Such debris materials placed curbside for pickup may result in a violation being issued by the City.

Bulky waste, large items, white goods, and remodeling debris may be placed curbside at any time but will be removed on the second collection day of the week. Residents will not need to call Waste Pro or the City for bulky waste pickup. Hazardous household waste will NOT be picked up curbside. This includes, but is not limited to, paint, motor oil, pesticides, gasoline, pool chemicals, etc.

DROP-OFF SITE

Kenner residents may bring debris to the City's drop-off site located at 1803 24th Street from 9 AM–3 PM on Saturdays and Sundays. Proof of Kenner residency is required.

**CONTAINERS MAY NOT BE PLACED CURBSIDE BEFORE 3 PM
THE DAY PRIOR TO PICK-UP AND MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE CURB
BY THE END OF COLLECTION DAY.**
