### **Kenner Secures \$8.092 Million in Federal Funding for Critical Sewer System Infrastructure Improvements**

*Secured through the leadership and support of Louisiana Congressional Delegation Members*

Kenner, LA — The City of Kenner, under the leadership of Mayor Mike Glaser, has secured \$8.092 million in federal funding through the Environmental Protection Agency's STAG—Clean Water State Revolving Fund, a key component of the Interior and Environment Appropriations bill's Community Project Funding/Congressionally Directed Spending program.

This significant investment was made possible through Mayor Glaser's collaborative efforts with U.S. Senators John Kennedy and Bill Cassidy, who secured \$7 million, and U.S. Representative Troy Carter, who secured an additional \$1.092 million for the City of Kenner. The funding will support vital repairs and upgrades to Kenner's extremely aged sewer infrastructure as well as critical upgrades to Kenner's Wastewater Treatment Facility, ensuring long-term reliability, environmental protection, and enhanced quality of life for Kenner residents. Mayor Mike Glaser praised the partnership and the impact this funding will have on the community,

"This \$8.092 million investment is a major win for the City of Kenner and a testament to what can be accomplished through strong partnerships at every level of government," said Mayor Glaser. "I am deeply grateful to Senators Cassidy and Kennedy and Representative Carter for their commitment to our city and for recognizing the importance of investing in critical sewer system infrastructure. These funds will allow us to continue protecting public health, strengthening our wastewater infrastructure, and building a more resilient future for our residents."

The STAG—Clean Water State Revolving Fund provides financing for projects that improve water quality, address aging infrastructure, and support environmental sustainability. This funding underscores the City of Kenner's continued commitment to responsible infrastructure investment and fiscal stewardship.
