CITY OF KENNER IN PARTNERSHIP WITH RESTORE LOUISIANA HOSTS MOBILE SUPPORT EVENTS FOR HOMEOWNERS

Kenner, LA. – (MAY 2, 2023) The City of Kenner in partnership with Restore Louisiana, will host two mobile supports events in Kenner to assist homeowners in completing a survey to receive assistance through the Restore Louisiana Homeowner Assistance Program. Survey completion is the first step to receiving aid, and hosting these events help to ensure that residents have the clarity and support needed.

The Restore Louisiana Homeowner Assistance Program provides grant funding to homeowners affected by Hurricane Ida, Laura, Delta or May 2021 severe storms. The federal program offers assistance to homeowners in a variety of ways including repair completion and home reconstruction assistance, as well as repair reimbursements.

“For many homeowners, the financial aftermath of Hurricane Ida and many other storms are still heavily felt, that’s why I’m pleased that the City of Kenner is partnering with Restore Louisiana to reestablish a sense of normalcy for many Kenner homeowner’s,” said Mayor Mike Glaser.

The first mobile support event will be held on May 3, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. at the City of Kenner Pavilion located at 3800 Loyola Ave. The second mobile support event will be held on May 25 from 9 a.m. to 4p.m. at the Kenner Council on Aging Center located at 641 Compromise ST.
